## A New Chapter: Upgraded Senior Library



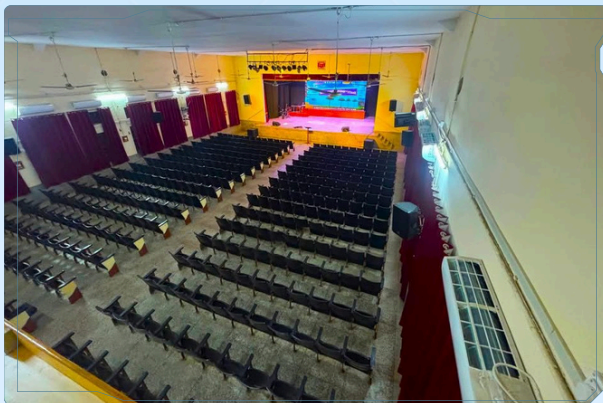
